Islamic religion is not worship only. Rather it
is a culture, an education and cultivation. It
educates man and cultivates him. It also
leads him to good. It opens to him doors of
knowledge. The greatest virtue of Islam is,
therefore, thought, work and cooperation.

Very strict rules were observed in the
schools. The children were often heavily
